
91:1-16

- **1** Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.
- **2** I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."
- **3** Surely, he will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence.
- **4** He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart.
- **5** You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day,
- **6** nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday.
- **7** A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you.
- **8** You will only observe with your eyes and see the punishment of the wicked.
- **9** If you say, "The LORD is my refuge," and you make the Most High your dwelling,
- 10 no harm will overtake you, no disaster will come near your tent.
- **11** For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways;
- **12** they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.
- **13** You will tread on the lion and the cobra; you will trample the great lion and the serpent.
- **14** "Because he loves me," says the LORD, "I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name.
- **15** He will call on me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him.
- 16 With long life I will satisfy him and show him my salvation."

We also engage to maintain family and secret devotion; to study diligently the Word of God; to religiously educate our children; to seek the salvation of our kindred and acquaintance; to walk circumspectly in the world; to be kind and just to those in our employ, and faithful in the service we promise to others; endeavoring in the purity of heart and good will towards all men to exemplify and commend our holy faith. We further engage to watch over, to pray for, to exhort and stir up each other unto every good word and work; to guard each other's reputation, not needlessly exposing the infirmities of others; to participate in each other's joys and with tender sympathy bear one another's burdens and sorrows; to cultivate Christian courtesy; to be slow to give or take offense, but always ready for reconciliation, being mindful of the rules of the Savior in the 18th Chapter of Matthew, to secure it without delay; and through life, amid evil report, and good report, to seek to live to the glory of God, who hath called us out of darkness into His marvelous light. When we remove from this place, we engage as soon as possible to unite with some other church where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's word.
